

Decision Summary – April 1 to June 30, 2017

The following establishments requested a hearing before the Licensing Appeal Tribunal regarding compliance issues and received suspensions of 14 days or more or revocations. | Establishment | Infraction | Sanction |

Other Suspensions/Revocations

Suspensions of 14 days or more and revocations where the licensee did not request a hearing before the Licence Appeal Tribunal.

| Asif's, Timmins | Permitted narcotics on premises; licensee failed to ensure control of premise was maintained | 14 days |
| Cargo KTV, Toronto | Permitted drunkenness | 17 days |
| Fancy | Overcrowding; non-compliance with "Fire Protection and Prevention Act" | 15 days |
